You Can Verify Child Support Information Online

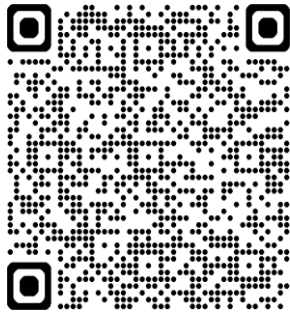
Good news! Child support payments can be verified online using the Child Support Verification Tool (CSVT). The CSVT is available 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.

OCS and the Michigan State Housing Development Authority (MSHDA) are expanding the availability of the CSVT to streamline the verification of child support payments for housing assistance applicants. The CSVT provides a simple way for you to verify these payments online.

OCS will stop processing child support verification requests on December 8, 2025.

To gain access to the CSVT:

1. Review the MSHDA policy related to using the CSVT – LIHTC Compliance Policy #5: Child Support Documentation;
2. Complete the Security Awareness Training and submit the Certificate of Completion for the training;
3. Review and sign the MSHDA Data Share Security Policy Agreement; and
4. Complete and submit the Enrollment Profiles/Security Agreement Form (1796b).

When your access to the CSVT has been granted by an authorized MSHDA representative, you will receive an email with directions on how to set up your account. Once you have an account, child support verifications will be quick and easy.
